Score Pilot is an easy-to-use control panel for timing and scoring in team sports. A large 10" touchscreen gives a clear overview during the game, while physical buttons around the screen put the most-used actions one press away — eyes on the game, not the menus.

A thumb-friendly rocker-type Start/Stop clock switch with integrated status LEDs lets operators keep their eyes on the game, not the panel.

Multiple databases for different sports in the same arena. Create and save configurations per sport and pin them to the home screen.

Seamless two-way data connection with Sport In The Box and accessories over Ethernet — plus standalone HDMI scoreboard output.

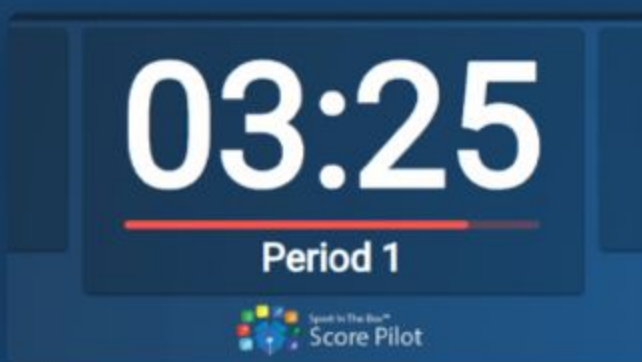
02 BUILT FOR EVERY SPORT

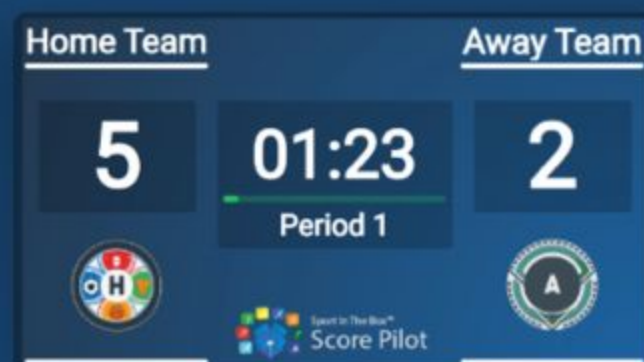
Full scoreboard

A built-in HDMI output drives a TV or scoreboard directly as a standalone solution. For larger venues, Score Pilot connects to Sport In The Box over Ethernet for a secure two-way data link — game data and teams in sync.

Timed buzzer changes

For entry-level games, stop the countdown and sound the horn after a set time so whole lines can change before play resumes.
